Dear Friends,

In the preparation for the European Athletics Championships 2022 to take place in Munich/GER from 15 to 21 August 2022, we would like to present you the following important information about the event.

**Preliminary Entries**

We remind you that the Preliminary Entries will be open from **Wednesday 02 to Thursday 17 March 2022** at 14:00 CET.

All European Athletics Member Federations are requested to enter their teams' information into the European Athletics Entry System, providing the most accurate possible data to allow the Local Organising Committee to plan all logistical arrangements accordingly.

Please note that the qualification monitoring tool "**Road to Munich 2022**" is available on the European Athletics website <https://www.european-athletics.com/competitions/european-athletics-championships/qualifying-system>.

**Covid-19 Regulations**

Due to the still ongoing pandemic situation, European Athletics and the Local Organising Committee are following the Covid-19 regulations for big events, as confirmed by the German Government. It has been confirmed that the "2G" rule will be implemented for the European Championships 2022 for all accredited and non-accredited participants. As of now, the "2G" rule is the following:

- Vaccinated
  - Two vaccinations (valid 14 days after the 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination and valid for 270 days)
  - Two vaccinations and a "Booster" (valid for 12 months after the Booster date)
  - Recovered and one vaccination (valid immediately after vaccination)
- Recovered
  - Proof of a positive PCR test (valid after minimum 28 days and not older than 90 days)

You will find in the attached appendix (**Appendix 1**) the list of vaccines recognised by the German authorities.

**Should you be vaccinated with a non-recognised vaccine, you will be requested to present a negative PCR test done within 48h prior to arrival in Munich and you will have to be tested every 48 hours. All tests will be at individuals'/Member Federations' costs.**

Please note that currently FFP2 masks are still mandatory in Bavaria, indoors and outdoors as well as in public transport.

All these measures are subject to change.
